I am a performer, teacher, choreographer, director, dabbler, wanderer and above all, a wonderer.

 and expression in performance. I personally taught: silks, corde lisse, lyra, trapeze, hula hoop,
 juggling, jump rope, dance, theatre, rhythm building and choreography. The most important task
 during my stay was devising, choreographing and co directing an original show, Swagatam, in
 preparation for the companies first UK tour.

Circus of the Kids is a travelling children's circus school. My roles included teaching Web, Silks,
